**Please, help us**

In our Faculty meetings and during numerous conversations with teachers, we have noticed some things that appear to not be well known by students. We want to remind you, so that you can tell your child. These are our expectations:

**Lunchroom:**

1. Use proper manners
2. Treat others with respect
3. Stay seated for 10 minutes
4. Raise hand
5. Eat all their food (if a student does not finish their food they should return it to their lunchbox—do not throw it away!)
6. Drink all their milk
7. Use indoor voices
8. Not throw food
9. Clean up area
10. Return lunch pails to class basket

**Playground:**

1. No tag games
2. No piggyback rides
3. No picking up other students
4. No wrestling or tackling
5. No food or drink
6. No wall-ball
7. No picking up rocks or sticks
8. No playing on the stairwell

**Gravel Area:**

1. No side to side swinging
2. No circular motion swinging
3. Only bottoms on swing (no swinging on bellies, or standing up)
4. No running under swing
5. NO PUSHING OTHERS ON SWING
6. No jumping off of the swing
7. Only one person at a time on the monkey bars
8. Monkey bars in one direction

**Soccer Field:**

1. No tackle football
2. No body slamming
3. No running in the sprinklers
4. No fighting

**Respect for Duties. Supervisors and Adults: Before School Care, During Recess, Lunch and After School Care:**

1. Respect all adults at all times
2. Follow directions those adults are giving
