3. School Improvement Process: results of the target areas from the last accreditation process
4. Student Learning Expectations: what we expect from our students as an outcome when they graduate from our school
5. Organization for student learning: General Curriculum; Religion and Math; Support for Student Personal, Social, and Academic Growth; Management and Development
6. School Improvement Plan which identifies the target areas for the next accreditation cycle
